

## 1. The Expanded Pacific Ocean

*In order to reflect the importance of the strategic value of the islands in the Pacific Ocean, the IPC values of most islands have been increased. Every attack that the US Task Force launched during the Pacific campaign weakened the Japanese influence, morale and economy.*

The increased strategic IPC values and number of units in the territories/islands in the Pacific Ocean now look like this (**Note:** the following infantry, fighter & AAA setup is in addition to any units that may already be in those territories/islands from the original G40 rulebook, whereas the new IPC value replaces the original IPC value of these territories/islands):

### United States:

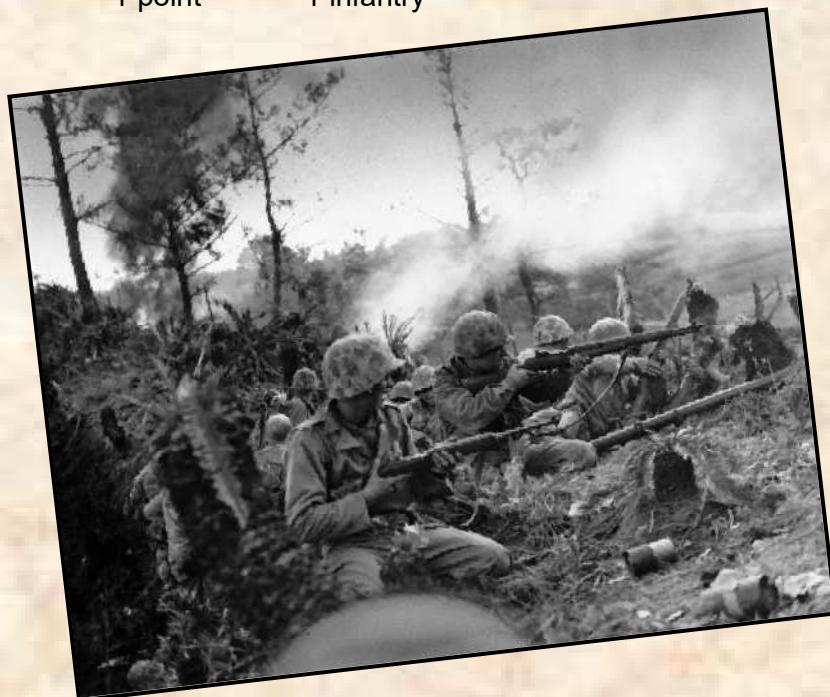
• Alaska	5 points	3 infantry + 1 AAA
• Midway	3 points	2 infantry + 1 AAA
• Hawaiian Islands	4 points	2 fighter plane + 2 infantry + 1 AAA
• Mexico	4 points	2 infantry
• Wake Island	2 points	1 infantry
• Philippine Islands	5 points	1 fighter plane + 2 infantry + 1 AAA
• Guam	1 point	1 infantry
• Aleutian Islands	1 point	
• Line Islands	1 point	

### India, ANZAC & Dutch:

• Borneo	4 points	1 infantry
• Ceylon	1 point	
• Gilbert Islands	2 points	2 infantry
• Fiji	1 point	
• Samoa	1 point	
• Solomon Islands	2 points	2 infantry + 1 AAA
• Dutch New Guinea	2 points	
• New Guinea	2 points	2 infantry

### Japan:

• Okinawa	2 points	1 infantry
• Caroline Islands	3 points	2 infantry + 1 AAA gun + 2 fighter
• Formosa	2 points	2 infantry
• Iwo Jima	2 points	1 infantry + 1 AAA
• Hainan	1 point	
• Paula Islands	1 point	1 infantry
• Marianas	1 point	1 infantry



Place the *IPC Value* markers on the game board according to the new IPC values outlined above.



Industrial Complexes cannot be built on these islands/territories. The increased value of these islands/territories does not have any effect on each nation's income level at the start of the game – each nation begins the game with their normal amount of IPC.

When either side during the War conquers any of these islands/territories the income level is corrected in the same way as with the original G40 rulebook but according to the new IPC value.

**Example:**

The USA conquers the Japanese island Okinawa and increases its income level with 2 IPC – and Japan has its income level reduced by 2 IPC. No Nation can receive less IPC than the IPC value of its Capital, no matter how many territories and islands are lost to enemy forces – unless the Capital is concurred by enemy forces.

**Note:**

Convoy disruption is according to the original IPC value of these islands/territories – not the new IPC value mentioned above.

**Naval Task Force:**

Use the Task Force boards and counters when any sea zone is crowded.
